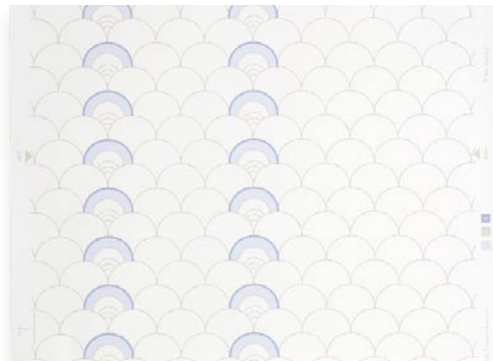

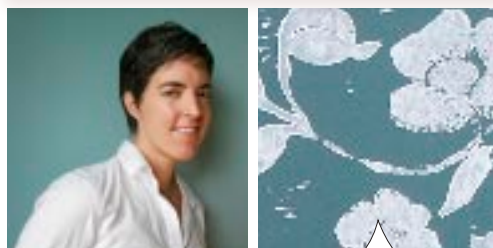
White-Tipped Matches
